The Senate resolved to consider and approve the request to condone the delay in submission of Ph.D research proposals by Ph.D Research Scholars.

As per Ph.D regulations of the Institute, Research scholars have to submit the proposal within two years of joining the programme.

The delay in submission of the research proposal by the above listed Ph.D scholars may be condoned.



Item No. 66.3.4: To consider and approve the issue related to Comprehensive Exam for Ph.D Research scholars - Reg.

Agenda Item

As per NITK-Regulations (Ph.D), Comprehensive exam will be conducted once in a semester and a student registered for Ph.D should qualify in this exam within one and half years from the date of registration. A student is deemed to have qualified in this exam if he/she obtains 60% marks in the exam and satisfactorily completes the oral exam. If a student performs non-satisfactorily in the oral exam, he/she needs to retake only the oral exam. A maximum of two attempts to qualify in the comprehensive exam will be given. If a student does not qualify in the comprehensive exam even after two attempts, his/her registration will be terminated. The question paper for comprehensive exam would be set by the respective DRPC.

Some of the Ph.D students are requesting to write the comprehensive exam within 6 months after joining the programme. The student may be permitted to write the Comprehensive exam after the completion of instructional period of one semester. The comprehensive exam to be conducted soon after completion of end semester exam of odd and even semesters.

Senate Resolution

The Senate resolved to permit the Ph.D research scholars to write the comprehensive examination after the completion of one instructional semester. The comprehensive examination is to be conducted in the second week of every semester.

Item No. 66.3.5: To consider and approve 3 instructional classes and/or one lab session under medical emergencies for attendance shortage. – Reg.

Agenda Item

To account for approved leave of absence (Eg. Representing the Institute in sports, games or athletics; placement activities; NCC/NSS activities; etc.) and/or any other such contingencies like medical emergencies, etc., the attendance requirement shall be a minimum of 75% of the classes actually conducted. A maximum of seven days attendance in a semester may be granted to those students who have been absent for participating in curricular and extra-curricular activities after due approval from the Institute.

As per regulations, a student with less than 75% attendance in a course during a semester in lectures, tutorials and practicals taken together as applicable, will not be permitted to appear in the End Semester Examinations of the course in which the shortfall exits, irrespective of his academic performance and irrespective of nature of this absence. He shall be awarded 'FA' grade in that course.

Students are approaching for condone the attendance shortage due to health issues. They produce medical reports and it also certified by NITK Health Care Centre. In such cases also students are getting FA grade. In view of this it is proposed to condone a maximum of 3 instructional classes and or one lab session in each course subject to production of medical certificate issued by NITK Health Care Centre.

Senate Resolution

The Senate resolved that attendance in every lecture, tutorial practical session of every course is compulsory. If the student has sought permission to avail leave in advance with the course instructor or has post-fact provided valid reasons to avail leave may be condoned up to 25% of the total number of the sessions subject to the conditions listed regulations G7 and G8 (Attendance requirements and Absence during the semester).

Item No. 66.3.7(b): Curriculum Review and Revision - Reg.

Director highlighted the need to evolve a new curriculum structure and effective pedagogy considering the challenges faced by the current generation of students. Theory courses need to be augmented with real-life case studies and industry expert lectures. Students will also benefit from more weightage to practical work (labs, team projects, industry internship, etc.), physical activities (sports, NCC, NSS, etc.), cultural clubs (with creative outputs), technical clubs (leading to innovation), and entrepreneurship (business planning). He exhorted the faculty to provide their valuable inputs and assist in evolving and implementing the new curriculum from AY 2024-25.
