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SECTION-1 Terms and Conditions

- 1. The rates should be quoted for preferably FOR destination from supply within India.
- 2. The bidder shall indicate the excise duty exemption for the goods if applicable.
- 3. The rate quoted should be on unit basis. Taxes and other charges should be quoted separately, considering exemptions if any. The rate should be quoted in INR only

- 13. EMD must be in the form of Bank Guarantee Annexure-D (Fixed Deposit Receipt/Insurance surety bonds/DD/e-Payment mode (through Credit/Debit cards / Net Banking). It will be valid for 180 days from the date of opening of the tender. In case of EMD payment made through E-Payment, UTR Number with details should be uploaded. The firm registered with MSME/NSIC as per MSME procurement policy order 2012 will be exempted from submission of EMD. Intended parties will have to give proof of registration along with their tender. Detailed Technical Specifications for Auto Active Tuning Antenna Setup

Auto Active Tuning Antenna Setup integrates a portable transceiver, an auto tuning antenna and a USB-powered radio interface. The portable transceiver in this setup operates across a wide frequency range, providing robust transmission power and sensitive reception capabilities. This transceiver connects seamlessly with a USB-powered radio interface, allowing for efficient audio processing and adjustment of levels tailored to different radio connections. This portable transceiver setup also connects to a portable auto active tuning antenna that covers frequencies from 7 to 430 MHz, ensuring optimised signal transmission and reception. Together, these components create an integrated system enabling straightforward and reliable amateur radio communication across diverse frequencies and conditions.

Auto Active Tuning Antenna covers amateur bands at frequencies of 7, 14, 21, 28, 50, 144, and 430 MHz, providing versatility across various radio frequencies used by amateur operators. It stands approximately 4.59 to 5.24 feet tall (1.4 to 1.6 meters) and weighs approximately 1.98 pounds (900 grams). The antenna has an input impedance of 50 ohms and can handle a maximum input power of 120 watts in SSB/CW mode with a 50% duty cycle. It is designed to achieve a matched Standing Wave Ratio (SWR) of less than 2.0 : 1 when properly installed with a suitable counterpoise, ensuring efficient transmission and reception across its specified frequency range.

The USB-powered radio interface features audio frequency response from approximately 200 Hz to over 4000 Hz at 600 ohms. It supports 16-bit sampling at rates up to 48kHz and is compatible with Windows (98SE to 11), macOS (9.1 or later, and OS X 10.00 or later), and Linux. The hardware includes a 600 ohm impedance for radio in/out, with adjustable TX/RX levels for Hi-Z and Low-Z connections. It incorporates an adjustable Auto-PTT[™] delay from 30 ms to 3 seconds, utilising a relay-based PTT circuit with a rating of 1A @ 24VDC (max) or 0.5A @ 120VAC (max). Connections include RJ-45 for TX audio, RX audio, PTT, and ground, and 3.5mm mono connectors for RX audio/speaker and auxiliary speaker (wired for mono operation). Housed in a custom extruded aluminium case, it measures 1.6" x 3.2" x 3.6" and weighs 6.6 ounces, operating reliably within a temperature range of -30°C to +60°C.

Portable Mobile Transceiver is an amateur radio transceiver operates on a frequency range of 1.8 to 54 MHz for transmission (limited to amateur bands) and 30 kHz to 56 MHz for reception. It offers channel steps of 2/5/10 Hz for SSB and CW modes, and 10/100 Hz for AM and FM modes. Frequency stability is +/- 0.5 ppm from 14 °F to +122 °F (-10 °C to +50 °C). Supported emission modes include A1A (CW), A3E (AM), J3E (LSB, USB), and F3E (FM), with an impedance of 50 ohms unbalanced and a supply voltage of 13.8VDC +/- 15%, negative ground.
