UG 4th Year:

Current UG 4th year student can contest for the roles of Students' Council President

Common Guidelines

- Candidate should have CGPA of seven (7.0) and above.
- Candidate must submit their manifesto along with the nomination form. Failure to do so can result in rejection of the candidature.
- Candidates should not have any active backlogs while contesting for the election.
- All Candidates should fill the nomination form and submit it along with a xerox copy of Institute ID Card and all the previous semesters grade cards to the returning officer in the Dean Students' Welfare office with self-attestation.
- Any candidate whose conduct and character are questionable will be barred from contesting the election.
- The students against whom disciplinary actions were taken either by the Institute or any other Government authorities are not eligible to contest for the election.
- If more than one candidate is proposed/seconded by the same student all nominations proposed/seconded by him/her stand rejected. If a student who is also a contestant, proposes another student, then both nominations will be canceled.
- The candidate should not have been involved in any anti-social (comments based on caste, religion, gender etc.), anti-national and other criminal activities in the past.
- Canvasing through print media is not allowed.
- Competing candidates may indicate a clear roadmap for campus, student life, academics, technical, cultural, curricular, co-curricular, health and wellness, and inter departmental activities should specify in their respective manifesto.
- All the contestants must be a Hosteller/Resident of NITK Campus.
- Decision of the Institute authority is final in the case of all other issues/conflicts that would arise.
- After the election, if the elected member fails to uphold harmony, integrity and transparency among the members and student community will be removed from the post.
- Any form of procession/celebration after the election is not allowed.
